My name is Rich Kurz and I am an experienced graphics design professional. My philosophy has grown simpler through the years. Good design is not about me, but about us. I want to do good work that serves the needs of my client and that I am proud to put in my portfolio. This pdf shows some of my capabilities.

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The challenge was taking the DiscipleLand Sunday School sequence for 2nd graders and creating a visual progression tied to it. All six elementary grades used a set of cartoon children created by the artist Rob Lassiter. Budgets are tight of course, so I would create the backgrounds and desktop publish it all together.

The 2nd grade fourth unit (2D) presented the gospel as a message beginning with salvation and progressing to living a life producing the fruit of the Spirit. With all that in mind, I art directed a journey adventure covering 10 lessons. Rob's characters advance from the lowlands towards a mountain. It requires the cross to traverse a canyon. They arrive at the distant mountain and scale it. At the top, they discover not the setting sun, but a shining tree of spiritual fruit. The backgrounds would be mine and Rob's art would interact with it. So both the lesson and the art would have a progression, the art reinforcing the idea of a life progression and adventure in its own subtle way.

The last two pages show the same approach used for a 1st-grade level set of lessons. This time, we were using village life in the time of Jesus as the setting for each week's lesson. For this set, I used one wide, continuous scene and shifted as the background.
