My name is Rich Kurz and Lam an experienced graphics design professional. My philosophy has grown simpler through the years. Good design is not about me, but about us. I want to do good work that serves the needs of my client and that I am proud to put in my portfolio. This pdf shows some of my capabilities.

The sophomore year was the first real year in one's design major doing projects. that were field-specific. Industrial design was more than just styling. It was also about making things that worked and worked better. The emphasis was on thinking outside of the box and on brainstorming a solution. But there was also trial and error.

We had two egg problems to solve: support an egg over a 30-inch span, and have an egg survive a one-foot freefall intact. One could use 1/16" balsa and thread. We were scored 10 points per inch of balsa and one point per inch of string.

Wes and I independently converged on the same solution for the span problem, with slight construction differences. It was not the perfect solution, but it counted. I won't show our solution because that would be telling, but I show the scores for the class. For some reason, they called me "Dick" and not "Rich".

The freefall problem had a more obvious solution and it was a matter of refinement and luck. I was middle of the pack for that one. The photo shows my first drop.

Deliverables: Two structures constructed of 1/16" balsa strips and thread
